Clinical Mental Health Program

This degree track prepares students for licensure in clinical mental health counseling who plan to work in an agency, private practice, or other relevant setting. Students matriculate through a series of core, specialized, elective, and clinical courses and must obtain a minimum of 60 credit hours.
